FIELDS OF APPLICATION

STABILISIERER UW70HH (ST) is a highly effective admixture that achieves very high erosion resistance and significantly reduces the segregation of fresh concrete upon contact with water.

STABILISIERER UW70HH (ST) is particularly suitable for the following applications:

- Underwater concrete
- Concrete for bank protection of inland waterways and rivers
- Drainage concrete
- Self-compacting concrete
- Pile concrete
- Diaphragm wall concrete
- Fiber-reinforced concrete

When used for concreting of verges STABILISIERER UW70HH (ST) largely prevents the washout of cement paste.

DOSAGE

Recommended dosage rage from 0.02 - 2.0 mass-% of the cement content.

WORKING PRINCIPLE

STABILISIERER UW70HH (ST) increases the viscosity and cohesion of the concrete. As a result, the concrete develops a very high resistance to washout.

In environments with no pressure as well as under high concrete pressures, such as in bored pile or diaphragm wall concretes, STABILISIERER UW70HH (ST) significantly minimizes segregation of water and increases its water retention capacity.

PROCESSING INDICATIONS

STABILISIERER UW70HH (ST) should be added to the sand/gravel mixture and mixed for 30 seconds prior to addition of cement. Afterward the concrete can be produced as usual.

The mixing time must comply with the regulations defined in EN 206-1.

The consistency of the concrete can be adjusted by adding plasticizers and/or superplasticizers of our PANTARHIT® - line.

This product is not classified as hazardous according to the CLP regulations. See safety data sheet for further information.
